## Global health



Interested in learning more about health challenges around the world? What's more natural than travelling abroad to study global health?

We can offer you a 15 ECTS course in Global Health. For student nurses this can be combined with a 15 ECT clinical placement so you can stay an entire semester. The course begins in January 2017 and lasts 13 weeks for Erasmus students.

The study is a part of the Bachelor programme (BSc) in Nursing. However, topics in this course are interdisciplinary, making it possible for bachelor students from other health programmes to also join in.

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## COURSE CONTENT

The overall aim of the course is to gain knowledge and understanding of the political, socio-economic, environmental and cultural factors influencing health and disease. The course addresses current major global health issues and will focus on four main subjects:

Globalization and health determinants

Health promotion and illness prevention

Migration and health

Observational practice

## TEACHING/LEARNING METHODS

Learning activities will include lectures, group work, group tutorials, seminars, panel discussions, independent studies and project work. The final assessment is a home examination.

## PREREQUISITES

This course is offered in English and therefore requires a certain command of the English language, both spoken and written. International students are required to have completed 60 ECTS in a nursing bachelor programme or other health programmes prior to attending this course.
